RAYMOND B. WAS NOMINATED FOR THE POST OF PUBLIC PRINTER BY PRES. EISENHOWER IN APR. 1953. He was ~~the~~ head of it for years, the largest printing plant in the world. By 1956 his economical management policies had resulted in an \$8,000,000 increase in production with a 5% cut in costs, although wages of employees were raised six times. A very flattering article on his work appeared in Readers Digest in 1956 which drew the attention of Franz Blattenberger in Bavaria who wrote to ask if he was related. Unfortunately, Raymond B. had no knowledge or interest in Genealogy. Last year when I found Franz Blattenberger in the Munich phone book and wrote to him, he was very much surprised. I have since been in contact with the granddaughter of Raymond B. who helped supply the information. She lives in Wash, D.C.

In reply to your inquiry of August 13 regarding military service records, we are sending marked copies of our Information Leaflets Nos. 1 & 4, which describe the records available and explain the type of service that we are able to provide.

We have found a record of military enrollment or service in the Revolutionary War for a Gen. Platenberger in the published Archives, 5th Series, Vol. III, p. 799. However, because the original document is not in our custody, we cannot furnish an official certificate. I have traced this.

On the terms stated in sections 6 & 7 of Leaflet #4, we can provide you with a certificate under seal, based on an original document in our custody, indicating that one John Blattenberger served in 1781 as a Private, 4th, 5th and 6th Class, Lt. Col. James Ross's 8th Battalion, Lancaster County Militia, with the notation, "on a tour of Duty," according to the evidence of a Muster Roll dated 1781.

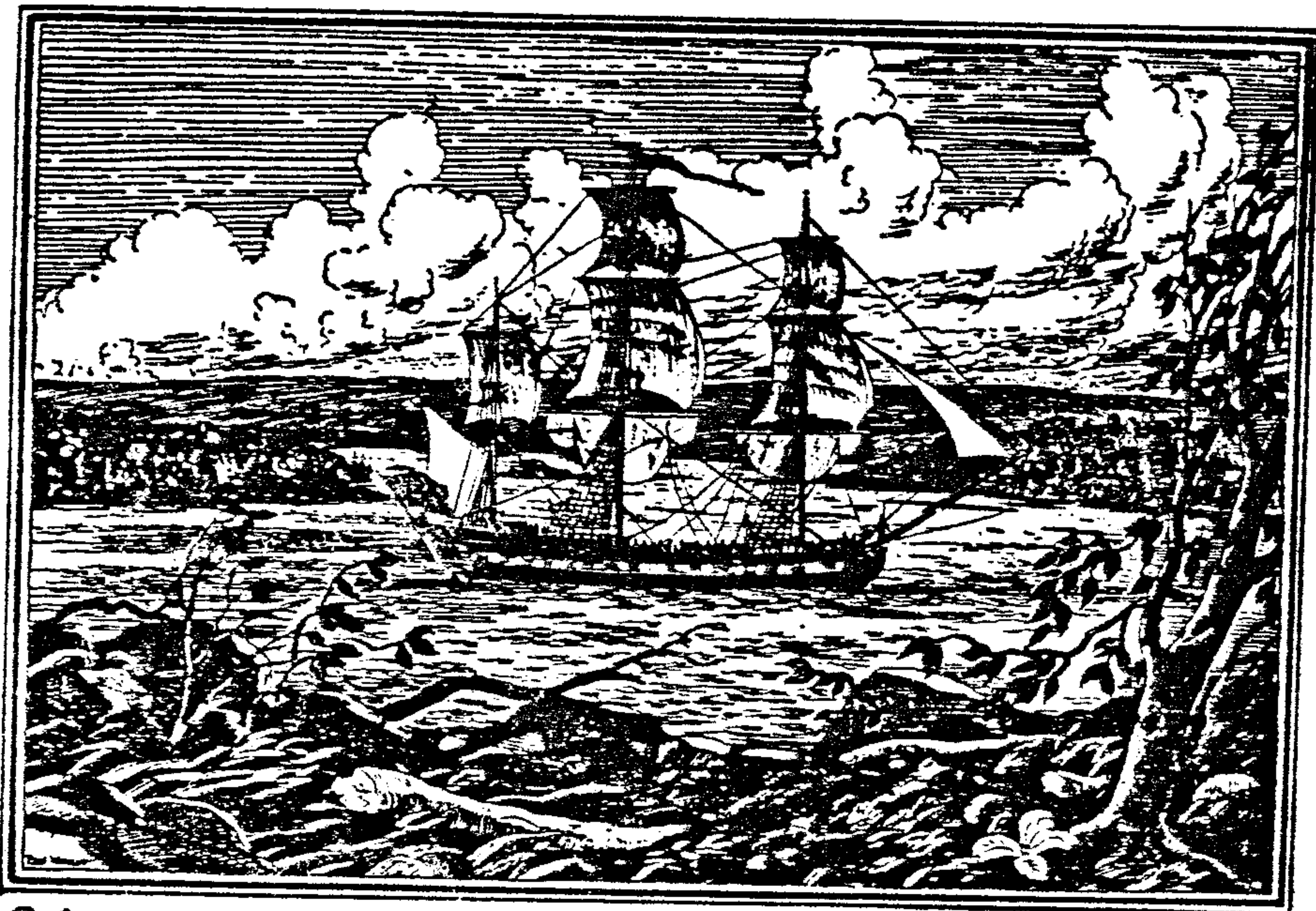
