

Additional Notes on Jacob Blattenberger:

Jacob enlisted on 19 Sep. 1862 in the Civil War most likely because of the threat of Confederate invasion. Two days prior to his enlistment, the deadliest day of the war - the Battle of Antietam - was fought near by in Maryland. Jacob was a member of Company H, 16th Pennsylvania Cavalry (161st Regiment Pa. Regiment). According to his pension records, he was shot in the right index finger during the Battle of Hartwood Church, Virginia in February 1863 and was treated by a regimental surgeon. He suffered no further wounds in the war. The 16th Pa Cavalry spent most of its time in the Virginia campaigns. Jacob mustered out as a Corporal on 16 June 1865. His name on the Pennsylvania Monument at Gettysburg reads "J Bluntenberger". Jacob's brother-in-law, John Cromer, fought in the same regiment.





Thanks for contacting me about the Haigler family.

I'm primarily interested in the descending Plattenberger genealogy, which is one of my ancestor families. Other than her parents, the ancestors of Mozella Haigler are not part of this genealogy since they are not Plattenberger descendants.

However, since Mozella Haigler was married to Louis Plattenberger, I would appreciate any information that you might be able to provide about Mozella (dates and locations of birth, death, marriage, etc.) and her descendants.

According to the SSDI, Lewis Plattenberger died on 26 Dec 1990 but I don't know where he is buried and I have no information at all about Mozella. Lewis and Mozella had two sons, William Robert Plattenberger and Grady Wayne Plattenberger, who are most likely still living but I don't know much about their families. Anything you might add would be appreciated.

Dear Stanley,

You asked what kind of information I had on the Plattenburgs.

I've been collecting information on the Plattenburgs for over 20 years. The name was originally Blattenberger but was changed to Plattenberger by some of the descendants and then shortened to Plattenburg by some later descendants.

The American ancestor of the family was Johann Ludwig Blattenberger, who arrived in America on the ship "Lydia" on 19 September 1743. Johann Ludwig was born 12 October 1721 at Hof Plattenberg, Bavaria, a son of Georg and Elizabeth (Wagenlechner) Blattenburger, Jr. He married Barbara Palmer, daughter of Johan and Christina (Majer) Palmer, while still in Bavaria. They came to America in 1743 with two of their children, Anna Maria and Philip, and settled in Warwick Twp., Lancaster Co., PA where they had eight more children. Johann Ludwig's first wife, Barbara Palmer, died on 26 January 1758 and Johann Ludwig remarried Margaretha Zimmerman, by whom he had two more children. Johann Ludwig died in March of 1794 at Manheim, Lancaster Co., PA.

By his first wife, Johann Ludwig Blattenberger had five sons, who married and had families of their own. They were Daniel, Johannes, Christian Ludwig, Frederick and Peter.

I have a lot of information about descendants and also have a computer database which contains everything I know about the family. Over the past several years, three Plattenberger reunions have been held, one at Martinsburg, PA and two at Lancaster, PA. Several hundred people attended each reunion and exchanged a lot of family information. I'm descended from one of Johann Ludwig's sons, Christian Ludwig Plattenberger, who lived for a time in Nazareth, PA.

If you will let me know the names of your Plattenburg parents and grandparents and the dates of birth and death, I can check my files to see if I can link you into the family tree.

In the past you have expressed an interest in the book on my father's ancestors that I have been working on. I'm happy to say it has gone to the printer and I don't plan to order extra copies or go into the bookselling business. If you would like a copy I would appreciate it if you would notify me by return mail.

The book is 335 pages on acid free paper, hard bound or softbound. Size, 8 1/2x11", has an 11 page everyname index with over 2400 entries. Each of the 71 family groups included has a family group sheet and narrative and leads back to the 28 immigrant ancestors of my father, Homer D Cassel,MD

The book was written for my family and not intended as a "scholarly work." I have tried to make it attractive to family members who are not genealogists and still give some help to other genealogists who are interested in the families of the 28 immigrant ancestors I have discovered. I don't have footnotes as I find them distracting. But after each narrative a list of sources or references is given. Often the source of information is given in the narrative.

Much of the material in the book is work originally done by my aunt, Mabel Cassel Vernon and her aunt Lillian Deeter Ullery. Much of that is written from their personal knowledge, especially that in reference to more recent Ohio families. I found that they had made some mistakes but most of it accurate enough that I was able to document all the early OHIO families well enough to get them into Ohio Genealogical Society's "First Families of OHIO"

The book follows my family lines back to the immigrant ancestors. Each ancestor has a family group sheet as complete as I could make it, but I did not make an effort to include the descendants of that ancestor even though in some cases I have some information and would be glad to share any information I have. If I had put in everything I have, the book would have been way too long.

Major names appearing in this book are Cassel, Johnson, Dock, Godschalk, Detweiler, Reiff, Moyer from Montgomery Co.PA. Cassels of Dauphin Co. PA, Engle, *Treasurer* Shank, Plattenberger, Eby, Kreibil, Schock, Heisey, Shank from Lancaster Co. Brethren families are Deeter, Reed, Stutzman, Ullery, Shively, Thommen. North Carolina to Ohio families are Hoover, Mast, Pfautz, Byrkett, Sinks I hope this explains well enough what you will find in the book.

Joyce & Bonnie -

I just found your query on the Rootsweb bulletin board. I don't go there frequently, but we've been doing web searches after the recent Blattenberger/Plattenberger reunion.

I know you and I have corresponded before Joyce, and I know that our official family genealogist Dale Berger (cc'd here) has received your information. I don't believe we've made the exact connection yet, but there are enough clues that I think that will just be a matter of time.

Bonnie - your information is entirely new to me, and I suspect to Dale as well. It's extremely interesting to my line which comes from Monroe Co. PA and almost always spells the name Plattenburg. (one of only two lines to spell it that way) I'd like to receive the info you've gotten from McKeesport and also any other NY state info you've gathered.

You mention you believe that the father of Joseph and Irwin is a Jacob and Nellie Plattenburg, and that Jacob was born around 1814 in Germany. What source of information do you have on that? Is it possible the name and date is reasonably correct, but the place is not? I do think you mentioned that the 1880 census record of Irwin says his parents were born in PA??

The two Plattenburg spellings come from either my line in Monroe Co. PA, or another one from the West Virginia pan handle. I believe one of the WV line has commented that some of them did cross over the border in both directions - eastern Ohio and western PA. My direct descendant is a Jacob Plattenburg b. 1776. We know about some of his children for sure, others we are guessing at since there are few church records in this area around 1800-1810. The 1800 and 1810 census list numbers of children in age categories so that's why we believe there are more children. But we have no way of knowing whether those children survived to adulthood, etc.

In the WV line, we believe there is a Jacob Plattenburg, but do not have specific dates or much more information. From the birth dates of his siblings, it is possible he

might have been born in the time frame you mention.

Drop me a note and let's see if we can't shed some more light on this. You can send information to me, or Dale Berger. I'll always make sure he gets everything you send.
