>Thank you for your most interesting message about the parents of Salome
>Mueller (9 Aug 1744-13 Apr 1806). It looks like I was off on the wrong track
>when I identified her parents as Abraham and Magdalena (Fuhrman) Mueller, as
>shown in Burgert.

Well, then again maybe, maybe not. (see below)

>In your message you mentioned finding Johannes and Elizabeth (Frey) Muller
>"in Faulkner"? Do you mean Falkner Church or is this something else?

Nope that's the one, at least spelled that way in the IGI.
Franconia Township I believe??

>The records of the Moravian Church at Schoeneck say that Salome was born
"near
>Great Swamp in Bucks County". Is "Great Swamp" the same place as "Faulkner"?

I've never been exactly sure where the "Great Swamp" was other
than some where between Allentown/Bethlehem and Philadelphia.

>Does the IGI show a baptismal record for Salome Muller? If so, where was she
>baptized?

It does not show that, it shows a birth date however of
7 Sep 1735. This is the same as listed in Humphrey's
briths for Montgomery. So if the Moravian record is correct,
then this isn't the right Salome. My problem is that I've
looked high and low in for a record and I haven't found it.
I figured with the Humphrey's birth books I should be
able to, but there still is no record to be found.
There is a second Salome in b. Montgomery Co.,
but way later in 1798.

If the subject looks familiar, it should. I am quoting from some information when you and I first exchanged email addresses. I decided to do a little work on this line since I've gotten pretty far back in all of the other lines on my mom's side.

You quoted from Burgert here, the entry of Johannes Abraham Muller. I went to look for further Fuhrmann and Fickeisen references in the IGI to go back further, but I had alot of trouble finding the J. Abraham's info. And the Abraham's I found did not seem to have a Salome.

I rechecked the Faulkner's records using Humphrey's early births books and found Salome's parents were Johannes and Elizabeth Muller. I had no problem with Johannes knowing the German naming conventions, but his wife's name was supposed to be Maria Magdalena. I looked over the record in S&H that Burgert refers to and it's correct.

So I looked for a bit in some ship lists books and wasn't getting anywhere and was going to go to Humphrey's births for Northampton when I looked down and saw Humphrey's Early Northampton Families. I knew that he made a coupld of Muller families in it, but had previously assumed they were not the right ones based on the info you gave me.

This Muller family goes back to Johannes and Elizabeth

(Frey) Muller, and yep, they're the ones listed in Faulkner. The agreement between Henry Frey and his children was written and witnessed by Johannes Muller.

After I got the name of Elizabeth Frey, the Mullers were easy to track down in the IGI, and Salome is listed there with her mother's maiden name listed as Frey.

It's interesting that Humphrey lists Elizabeth Frey's husband as "Dr." Johannes Muller.
